However, undergraduates who are in their last year or those with extended school years have to take at least one subject. ● The paid credit fees are not refundable. The courses that dropped will be marked as "W"(withdrawn) on the transcript. ● Intensive courses cannot be dropped via 2nd course withdrawal.
